When you arrive, teachers will be in their classrooms. You are invited to either go to the door that your child will be using this year, or you can come to the front office to say hi, and to get directions to your classroom. Staff will be available to help families who are unsure where to go.

## Playground

We are so excited about our new playground, and we know you are, too! We want <u>all</u> our students to have an opportunity to enjoy the equipment safely, so we have a plan in place to start the year out. Teachers will be able to book time on the equipment for gym classes, Fit Kids, and other times during the day. At recess there will be a schedule, that includes a first recess rotation with Grade 6s using it on Mondays, Grade 5s on Tuesdays, Grade 4s Wednesdays, Grade 3s Thursdays, and Grades K-2 on Fridays. For the lunch recess, K-2 students will use the playground every day. In October we will assess how the rotation is working and will make adjustments as necessary.

# <u>Student Pick Up / Drop Off</u>

Please send or deliver students to school at 8:20 or later as there is no supervision prior to this time.

After school, supervisors need to clear the playground by 3:20 so that they have the visual that all students have left or have been picked up.

## Parking

The west parking lot is for staff parking; no parent/guardian parking is available here in the morning or after school, however you may loop through to quickly drop students off. As you exit, remember that there is no left turn when exiting and it is a "blind corner", requiring you to stop before the sidewalk, which the police enforce frequently.

Please, park in the GARC parking lot whenever possible. GARC requests that we be as courteous as possible as they have clients trying to park in order to get to various courses and scheduled events.

## <u>Cell Phones & Other Electronic Devices</u>

There is government legislation regarding personal electronic devices in schools and this is used to determine Elk Island Public School Board Policy 24 and AP 145, which require that students in Divisions 1 and 2 (Grades K-6) not access a Personal Communication Device while at school, unless required for: diagnosed medical conditions; or an identified inclusive educational need.



This means that students are not allowed to use cell phones or personal devices during the day. If a student brings a device, the homeroom teacher(s) will inform them of the process for storing them.

Students may come to the office to use the phone if they have forgotten their lunch or other similar scenarios. You are welcome to phone the office if you need, for example, to let your child know of a change in how they will be getting home. We will share that information with your child. Please try to call as early as possible (ex. Prior to 2:00) as classes are often outside at the end of the day.

## Parent Council and Fundraising Society

We have our first Parent Council meeting on September 19<sup>th</sup> at 6:00. You can park in the east parking and use the east doors which will be locked at 6:00. If child care is tricky, you may wish to join virtually. The link will be available on the website closer to the date. Our Fundraising Society meets immediately after the Parent Council meeting and we are always looking for VOLUNTEERS to support our fundraising initiatives.
